8. Music Board Report

Tom Weithers One proposed rule change – music board may recommend the waving of some adjudication criteria. An individual in a different North American Association has a wealth of musical education/adjudication qualifications and would make an excellent judge, but doesn't possess the current prerequisite knowledge required to be a pipe-band judge. The addition of the G4 S/R solo event has helped the Music Board in determining whom to upgrade, so this change in our 2022

rules was a positive change.

9. Vice-President's Report

Scott McCawley

"I do whatever Jim asks me to do." The MWPBA is changing the location of the McHugh/Enright/Swinton solo event to the Park Ridge Presbyterian Church. The 2023 McHugh/Enright event will be on March 23rd, the 2023 Swinton Professional event will be on May 4. Andrew Lewis has recommended putting the Macalester Indoor competition on Feb 7.

10. President's Report

Jim Sim

The board had a "Zoom retreat" in April which was very effective, given the geographically diverse nature of our group. Jim thanked the current board. Review of all games in 2023. 2024 information: Minnesota games should be July 15, 2024. Review of Alma changes for 2024 (single day event on Saturday May 24; all solos & bands can play both sets, no mandatory noon massed-bands attendance requirement). Chicago will be changing venues due to more construction at the Hamilton Lakes location; likely to be the DuPage Co. Fairgrounds in Wheaton. We would have more space there. Grade 4 will be a medley contest to help attract G4 bands from Canada due to PPBSO requirements (Grade 4 bands play a QMM in PPBSO, in addition to a

medley). The Wisconsin Highland Games in Waukesha, WI will be on August 31. Tulsa should be Sept. 14 in Broken Arrow, OK. Winter Storm Jan 12-14. More workshops at Winter Storm 2024 geared to lower level players, plus interviews & panels. Solo entries are already full. Annual Highland Games Summit will be Saturday, Jan. 6. Highland Games organizers are always talking about money and predictability; sanctioned pipe-band contests are too expensive and unpredictable. Minimum Prize Money is not called out specifically for regular (standard) sanctioning, so we will update that into our official rules. The MWPBA will publish an updated "how to run a Highland Games" package for those who wish to run a sanctioned pipe-band contest. Education Initiative recommended: bring in a top PM & LD from an overseas (UK) Grade 1 band that can be hired out by local bands. MWPBA would pay for the initial travel to the U.S., and then the contracting band(s) will have to pay their instruction fees plus lodging. The MWPBA will run another e-mail survey to all member bands asking about their respective interest in contracting out this duo; an announcement will be made when these surveys go out. The MWPBA will host more Zoom remote instruction courses, one a month hopefully. Scheduled thus far are an Owen Russell will have a tenor/bass workshop that can be attended (location TBD), and a Strathspey/Reel (two-parted) class geared towards Grade 4 players will be conducted. Individual Scholarships – we've expanded them beyond pipers to drummers, and it has been very successful. We are going to expand it to other grades, but restrict it to soloists under 18. In order to improve the MWPBA's product on the field at sanctioned competitions, we will expand solo contests to have piping quartet contests; a quartet can play one grade above their current band registration, but will have to meet the musical requirements of that grade. We hope that this will be taken advantage of. Sponsors – we've had several new sponsors in 2023. Audio adjudication history: (brief overview of failed attempts in the past with micro-cassette recorders) - for 2024 we're looking to improve on this with a new piece of software called "CompetitionSuite". This software allows judges to record their commentary on a performance; this commentary is then uploaded to the cloud, and will be immediately accessible by the band being judged. It serves two purposes: 1) improves the efficiency of adjudicators by allowing them to speak directly into a recording device while the competition is in progress vs. writing that commentary 2) improve the quality of feedback to the bands - they will be able to hear what the judge heard along with the commentary. The software is relatively low cost, and is based on how many times it is used vs. a traditional purchase & yearly subscription fee. It will require the investment of some hardware (tablets); the software can run on an individual's phone, but it would be easier to manage/troubleshoot if the MWPBA owns the hardware outright vs expecting judges to download the software on their own mobile phones. In order to pay for the software fee (approximately \$7.00 per band per judge) the MWPBA will raise the band entry fees by \$15.00/event to cover the cost. There will be an adjudicator training session on this software in the Spring of 2024, and the MWPBA will be attending various band practices in the Chicago area to demo the software and hardware. There will also be a tech-support person per circle to cover issues. Additionally, the MWPBA is going to adopt the RSPBA method of tabulating scores. Reminder about due dates for solo registrations, rosters. Additional input from V.P. Scott McCawley - make sure each band has separate contacts per grade (band) so that surveys will have more accurate results (i.e. one organization provides an e-mail to us, but they might have three distinct competing bands within that organization, but we only get one response. With multiple e-mails, one for the Grade 2 band, one for the Grade 4 band, one for the Grade 5 band, etc. we will be able to obtain more accurate feedback from our surveys).

#4 – poor scoring sheets – hopefully moving to an audio based system (CompetitionSuite) may alleviate this issue;

#5 – The MWPBA lowered the travel money requirements in 2008 to help ease the burden on Highland Games organizers; we now propose to eliminate all travel money requirements to make hosting an MWPBA sanctioned event more predictable and budgetable. Dave Bruning (representative from the Wisconsin Scottish organization that hosts the Wisconsin Highland Games in Waukesha) amends our proposal to eliminate travel money and pay out a 4th placing vs. the current three placings. Motion passes unanimously.
