Parking & Suites:

Pipe Band members are asked to park in the Suite Parking Lot located on the East Side of the Sears Centre Arena and enter at the marked Suite Entrance. Take the Suite Elevator up to the Suite Level where bands will be assigned a Suite area to store items and prepare for competition. You can arrive any time at or after 11:00 A.M. **Please Note: The Suites open up to the main floor arena area. Please do not pipe in the suites while other events are going on. Use the outer suite area and close your suite doors. Final Tuning rooms are available on the floor level and are assigned to each band. Thank you.

Elevators:

The entrance to the Suites is accessed through the Suite elevator located in the Suite entry way. The ONLY Elevator to take bands from the Suite Level (S) to the Floor Level (F) is located near Suite number 31 and is covered in KIA Motors stickers. Be sure to allow for enough time for your band members to take this elevator down to the Floor Level prior to competition and to access the Final Tuning Rooms. This elevator will also access the Concourse (C) Level and will only be used by the pipe bands.

To enter the field use the corridor under Section 107. When finished, line up in rank, turn slight right and exit the field using the corridor under Section 112. No counter march. There will be a slight bump on the turf when entering and exiting the competition floor area. Be aware of this.

Please look for informational signage around the arena outlined in a blue and green tartan which will be specific to Pipe Bands.


Food & Drink:
