## **MWPBA Sanctioned Games -General Rules & Regulations-**

1. Competitions will be conducted under the Rules of the Mid-West Pipe Band Association (MWPBA).
2. MWPBA officials shall have the power to rule on all complaints and protests relating to the competitions of the day. All protests should be made in writing and lodged with the MWPBA officials within 7 days along with a \$10.00 fee that will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
3. The MWPBA disclaims any and all liability for injury to person or property related to the events it sanctions. The event sponsor, by accepting sanctioning, agrees to defend, indemnify and hold the MWPBA, its officers and agents harmless from all such liability. This disclaimer shall remain in effect despite the withdrawal of sanctioning by the MWPBA for any reason.
4. St. Louis Scottish Games disclaims any and all liability for injury to person or property related to the event, participants agrees to defend, indemnify and hold the St. Louis Scottish Games and hold the St Louis Scottish Games, its officers & agents harmless from all such liability.
5. Entry fee(s) must accompany entry form and be paid in U.S. funds. Checks are to be payable to SLSG. Bands must include their Competition Roster for these Games.
6. Bands and soloists must be a member of the MWPBA or a member of an affiliate association of the ANAPBA. For a full list of affiliate ANAPBA associations go to [www.anapba.org](http://www.anapba.org). For MWPBA membership information, call Tad Myers (Bands) or Tom Jewell (Solos). Contact info at [www.mwpba.org](http://www.mwpba.org)
7. All entries must be postmarked no later than September 8th, 2012. NO late, phone or field entries will be accepted.
8. Gate passes will be distributed to the Pipe Majors for competing members only. Soloists not members of a competing band will receive their gate passes with their confirmation of playing times.
9. Proper highland attire is mandatory for all band and solo performances.
10. All starting times are based on the "official" clock, located at the piping tent Soloists shall register with their judge's steward. A Soloist more than 5 minutes late may be disqualified and not "worked in" later.
11. Soloists and bands may play in only one grade as assigned by their home association.
12. The Piobaireachd Piper must supply music to the judge.
13. Solo SR and HJ to be played straight through.
14. Solo tenors shall supply 1-2 pipers and *may have* 1 snare too.
15. A pre-drawn Bands' Order-of-Play will be posted early in the week prior to the Games. Playing positions are official and final. All bands shall send a rep to the Piping Tent for the 10:30 Meeting and sign-in.
16. The last rule is to have fun!
