Directions for Pipe Bands and Solo Competition

Events are sanctioned by the Midwest Pipe Band Association (MWPA) as a Champion Supreme Games. A copy of Band and Solo schedules will be communicated to bands upon receipt of the completed entry form, entry fees and competition roster. A copy of Solo schedules will be communicated to Soloists upon receipt of the completed entry form and entry fees. See MWPA Rules at www.mwpa.org.

NO entries postmarked after 11/August/2012 will be accepted. Call if there is a question of your mailed entry arriving in time. Entry form and fees MUST be mailed by 11/August. All Bands and Soloists are required to be members in good standing of the MWPA or other Pipe Band Association or Society in order to participate. Enter your Membership Number on the entry form. Bands must include their competition rosters.

All competitors must appear in Highland Dress as defined by the MWPA. A Bands' Order-of-Play will be pre-drawn by the MWPA Chief Steward. A Band Rep must check-in his band and attend the 10:30 AM Meeting at the Piping Tent. Massed Bands & Final Tuning area will also be conveyed at 10:30. The official pre-drawn band order will be available on the Games website at www.wisconsinhighlandgames.org. Soloists must register with their station stewards for each event registered. A schedule of events and their locations will be posted outside the Games Tent. Piobaireachd pipers must supply notational music to the judge.
